## Overview

InfoAktiv software provides an extremely simple and powerful way to replace brochures and other handouts with interactive information pods. It is designed specially for 'face-to-face' situations such as events, stores, briefing centres and reception areas. Because it requires no specialized skills or new content it is very fast, easy and cost-effective to own and manage. InfoAktiv systems can be completely self-contained or internet-connected.

### InfoAktiv Demo

You can download InfoAktiv and it will run in 'Demo' mode. This allows you to display up to 6 PDF documents and collect a single piece of information from users who request copies of PDFs. This saves you the expense of printing documents, is environmentally friendly and automatically generates qualified leads by tracking who took what. InfoAktiv Demo can also be used to preview most content that Professional can display.

### InfoAktiv Professional

InfoAktiv Professional can display an unlimited number of PDF, PowerPoint, Video, MP3 and Flash files. You can also enable secure access to specified web pages and run other applications from InfoAktiv. You enjoy greatly enhanced user data collection and can automatically create and send emails when users request information. To activate InfoAktiv Professional you need a licensed USB security key or 'dongle'.

### InfoAktiv Content Manager

Content Manager provides an easy way to modify the appearance and operation of an InfoAktiv system. Use it to specify files, folders, backgrounds, banners, icons and 'attractor screens' (screen savers). It is also used to set up information gathering questions, email templates, web access rules, quizzes and standard attractor screens. A full version of Content Manager is supplied with InfoAktiv - Demo, enabling users to set up and test their content folders 'off-line'.

## Using InfoAktiv

Install the software, select a folder that contains the items you want to display, and click 'Start'. - It's that easy. You can have different folders for different occasions and just choose whichever one is appropriate on the day. As you get more adventurous you can use Content Manager and ordinary Microsoft Windows tools to manage and customize your folders.

## System Requirements

Essential for Demo or Professional:

- A PC running Microsoft Windows XP Professional Service Pack 3.
- 1280x1024 screen to run InfoAktiv - Demo or Professional.
- Content Manager requires a screen resolution of at least 1024x768.
- Adobe Acrobat Reader 8 or 9.

Advisable for Professional:

- Microsoft Office PowerPoint 2007 is required to display PowerPoint files or use one as an 'attractor screen' (screen-saver).
- Microsoft Office Outlook 2007 is required to create and send emails automatically.
- A touch screen or kiosk is recommended to provide the best user experience and security.
- Adobe Flash Player to play Flash files.
- Microsoft Windows Media Player with add-ins ('Codecs') to support required video formats.
